### Supplementary material B

#### **Qualtrics Panel Survey**

A sample of 100 respondents (18 years of age and up) was recruited by Qualtrics Research Panel, with the incentive of accruing points through Qualtrics' point system, where participants accrue points and redeem them for gift cards, skymiles, etc. Respondents were emailed a link to a web-based survey consisting of all 43 questions in the main study as well as all possible response options. For each question, they were asked to rate how embarrassed they thought most people would be answering each question during an interview. They were also asked to rate how embarrassed they thought most people would be to give each possible response option. Of note, the participants did not provide their own answers to each question. They simply rated the degree to which they saw each question and response option as embarrassing/sensitive.

For the 12 numerical survey questions that did not provide response options (e.g., number of sex partners, number of hours spent watching TV each day, number of days drinking), response categories were created based on data from Study 1. Three categories of response value ranges for each question were created based on the distributions of numerical responses in the first study, using a simple scheme: The value 0 was always included as one option, and the nonzero responses were dichotomized. That is, the next 50% of non-zero values was the range for the second option and the rest of the values were part of the third range; specifically, the third option consisted of anything greater than or equal to a particular value. For instance, using this method, the 3 options for hours spent watching TV included: 0, 1–3, 4+. Ranges for the credit card questions were rounded to avoid bizarre presentation (e.g., \$1–\$249; \$250+).

For each question and each response option, respondents were given 3 rating options: not at all embarrassed, somewhat embarrassed, very embarrassed. This allowed the response options to be ranked from most to least socially desirable among this panel, as well as dichotomized (based on a cutoff) into nonsensitive and sensitive (i.e., more than NOT sensitive, combining the second and third categories), in order to address the hypotheses about sensitive vs. nonsensitive questions and responses.

With regards to the hypotheses that use the panel data, it is important to note that the panel survey asked participants if they would be 'embarrassed' as opposed to their levels of 'comfort' or 'upset' (the terms used in the main study respondent ratings). The full Qualtrics panel survey can be found below.
